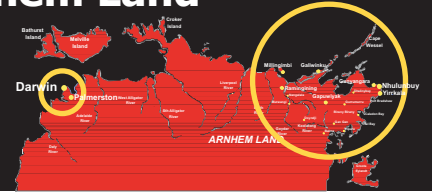


# Yolngu Radio

From the 1 November 2006, Yolngu Radio will be broadcasting in Darwin 24 hours a day, 7 seven days a week, using a new, more powerful transmitter and antenna installation.

Yolngu Radio delivers vital education to the Yolngu people in their own language on subjects such as Health, Law, Economics and Governance. Educational programs are interspersed with Yolngu contemporary and traditional music.

This is the first time such a service has been made available in Darwin, Palmerston and the rural area, completely in the language of the Yolngu people.
